Cost includes placing them. Someone thought the example looked unfriendly and wanted different fonts, we will work with Vernon on the fonts.

Had some violation letters for people to pick up if they needed them. The Board will not be policing the homes in Southfork, if people have a complaint they can fill out forms and we will look into the complaints.

Duane brought up the Fence Insurance if it should be covered, it is \$500/50,000 worth of coverage per year. Ron motioned to approve the amount and Steve seconded. All in favor, approved.
